

Bury Council Road Safety Team

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Bury Council Road Safety Team offer road safety in education lessons to different year groups in both Primary and High School.

These sessions are designed to develop road user knowledge and confidence amongst children, equipping them with the life skills required to use roads safely.

Sessions are delivered free of charge, but please book early in the academic year to avoid disappointment.

Primary School

Road Safety in Education lessons for Years 2 ,3 and 5.

Year 2 consists of 2 sessions, one 30 minute class based session and 60 minute pedestrian skills session outside on the highway.

Year 3 consists of a class based lesson of between 45 to 60 minutes duration.

Year 5 receive a pedestrian skills session on the highway of between 60 – 90 minutes depending on location.

National standards cycle training (Bikeability) is offered to Year 5 and 6 children, but children must be a minimum age of 10 years old to participate. This training is currently delivered by Nationwide Cycle Academy on behalf of Bury Council Road Safety Team.
